Course Objectives

- ✓ Gain an understanding of the intricate subtle components of typical and typical motor development and their interplay

- ✓ Gain an awareness of the principles of assessment and treatment used in NDT Baby Treatment and the appropriate application of these principles

Course Description

This intensive 5-day workshop is offered to Licensed OT's, PT's and SLP's who work with infants (birth-2 years) who have movement disorders. NDT certification is **not** required. The course provides detailed information on normal and abnormal development in the first year of life with an emphasis on assessment & treatment techniques. Participants treat infants in mentored practicum sessions. A review of basic anatomy is strongly recommended prior to attending the course.

Course Requirements

This is a course in which participants will be treating patients. Due to the patient practicum components of this course, participants must hold a professional license and carry professional liability insurance. Each course participant must submit proof of their license and insurance with their registration to participate in the course.
